

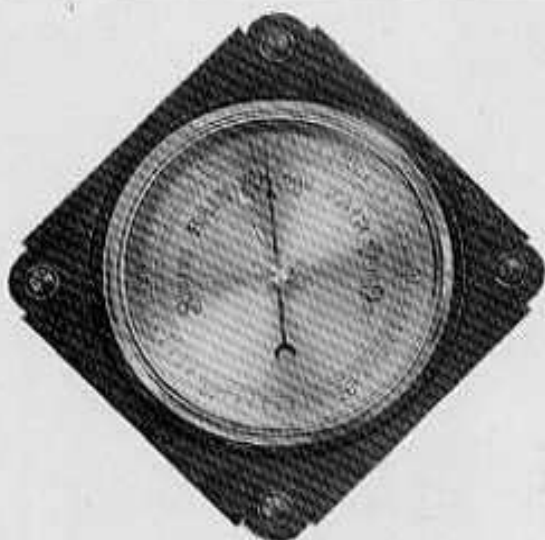

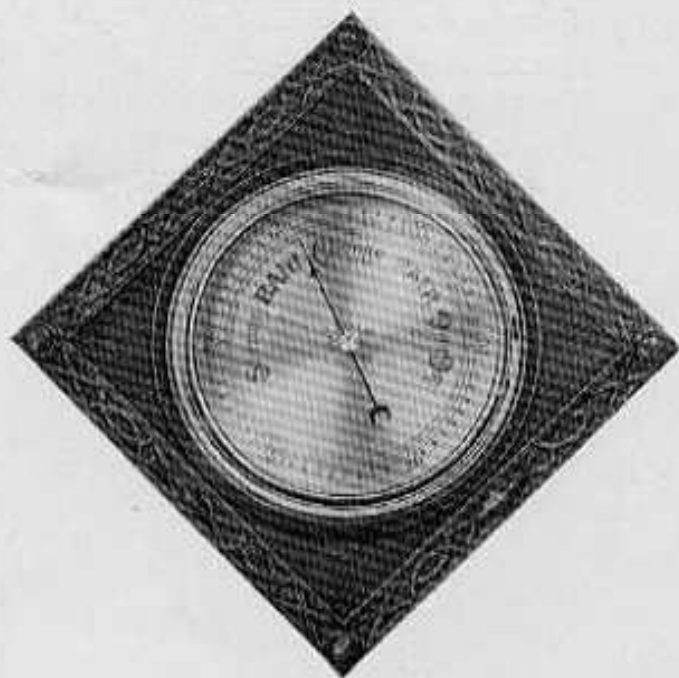

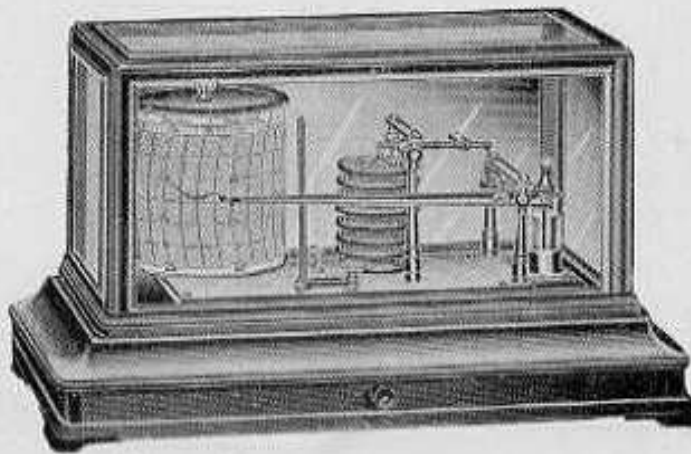

## EXPLANATORY

 THE following pages illustrate an assortment of Hall Aneroid Barometers, to which type they are confined. **Acme Barometers** represent an attempt to meet a demand on the part of our customers, *viz.*, for a more artistic variety of patterns, in accordance with the improved taste in decoration so evident in all directions. Coming into a market supplied—apart from some beautiful antiques—for the most part with crude ornamentation and stereotyped forms, they have been pioneers that have achieved a widespread effect and have been generally imitated. They will still, however, be found unique in style and finish, while the movements with which they are fitted are of the finest quality, London made, compensated for variations in temperature and fully guaranteed. With original designs in oak and mahogany, there are others still more original in lacquer, leather, brass and pewter. These afford a variety of models, true to antique period styles and harmonious with an exacting taste. The oak and mahogany are carefully chosen, of fine quality and thoroughly seasoned; oak, toned to a Jacobean finish, and mahogany either highly polished or “wax finish.” Dials are generally etched, silvered or lacquered grained brass. In some cases the one particular finish is recommended, and in those cases only one style is quoted, but with the other patterns, dials can be supplied either brass or silvered. With some models, antique bronzed dials with white figures have been introduced and found very pleasing.

With the Acme models are a further assortment of regular types, carefully selected to exclude ugly conventional patterns, and extending the range to include some of the smaller barometers, which meet the requirements of economy. The stock throughout is British make of reliable quality. The Barographs illustrated are of British make with best French movements, and can be relied upon to give lasting service.

Prices quoted are retail sale prices, and we request our customers not to reduce them. It is to be understood that Acme Barometers are supplied by us upon that condition.

A small charge is made for naming dials, *viz.* (two lines), Block 8d., Script 1/6. Goods are sent, failing specific instructions, by the cheapest transit, carriage forward. Cases and crates are charged at cost, but will be allowed for in full if returned with packing, carriage paid, in good condition, within 14 days.

Accounts are subject to 5 per cent. discount if paid by the 25th of the month following date of invoice.
